

DIRECTIONS TO PORT CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL

1. **From Cleveland:** Take I-90 W towards Toledo and follow as it becomes SR 2 W toward Lorain/Sandusky. Take the SR 163 W exit. Turn slight right onto SR 163 (E Perry St.) Turn left onto Jefferson St.

2. **From Columbus:** Take US 23 toward Delaware. Take ramp toward SR 53 (Upper Sandusky/Tiffin). Turn right on SR 53 N (Fremont-Tiffin Rd.) Take exit #95/Port Clinton/Lake Erie Islands onto SR 53 N (W Fremont Rd.) toward Port Clinton. Continue on CR 52. Turn right on 3rd St. Turn right on Jefferson St.

3. **From Toledo:** Take Ohio Turnpike I-80/I-90 E. Exit at SR 53 (Exit 91 Port Clinton). Continue on SR 53 N (W Fremont Rd). Continue on CR 52. Turn right on 3rd St. Turn right on Jefferson St.

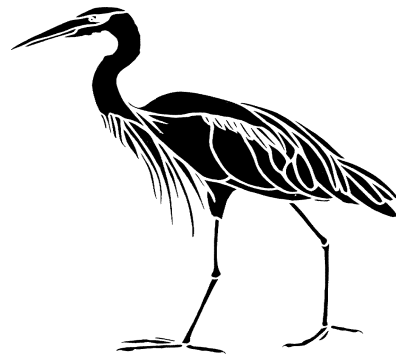
Follow SR 2 E. Take the Fremont exit. Turn left onto SR 53 N (W Fremont Rd.) Continue on CR 52. Turn right on 3rd St. Turn right on Jefferson St.
